# INSCRIPTIONS IN THE CATHEDRAL.

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Thorpe having included in his Registrum Roffense, published in 1767, copies of the Inscriptions then existing in the Cathedral, (*a*) the following list is only a continuation of his transcript, down to 1837; with the addition of a few Inscriptions anterior to 1767, which appear to have escaped him. It will be noticed that some of the Inscriptions are hidden by the Stalls, which were erected in 1880. These were copied previously to their being covered over, and I have been enabled to make use of the transcript, by the kindness of Mr. Arnold, in whose custody it is. Perhaps no apology is necessary for the omission of parts of some of the Inscriptions. Burn (*b*) points out that there can be no possible use in transcribing them in certain cases. I have only omitted such parts as contain no facts of historical or genealogical value, and have made in each case a note of the omission. All the following Inscriptions are in the Nave.

An Account of Burials in the Cathedral  
of Rochester, not to be found in the present

- 633 Paulinus, Bp. of Rochester, dyed October 10, 633, & was bur. in his own Cathedral [in secretario B. Apostoli Andreæ, quod Rex Ethelbertus construxit]. He was afterwards canoniz'd and inshrined. (*b*)

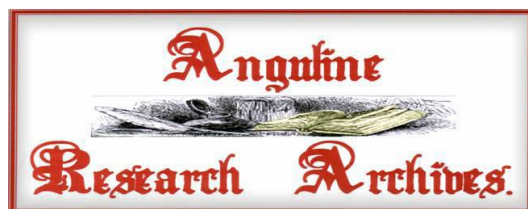
